- Do you find anything confusing?

- What part puzzles you?
- Is there anything tough to get your mind around?



4. What does this say about God?!

- What kind of things can we know for certain?
- How is God different than man?
- How does this change or illuminate your understanding of God?
- What do you wish you'd known before now?
